## 2 SERVICES PROVIDED

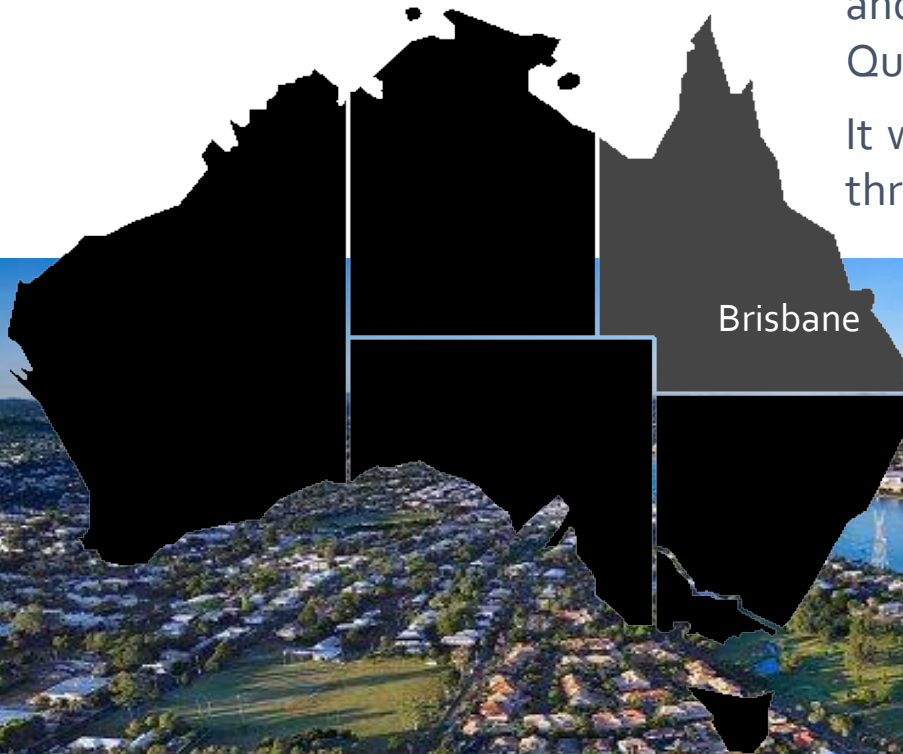

It will create an inviting space for the community in the heart of a thriving commercial, retail and residential precinct.

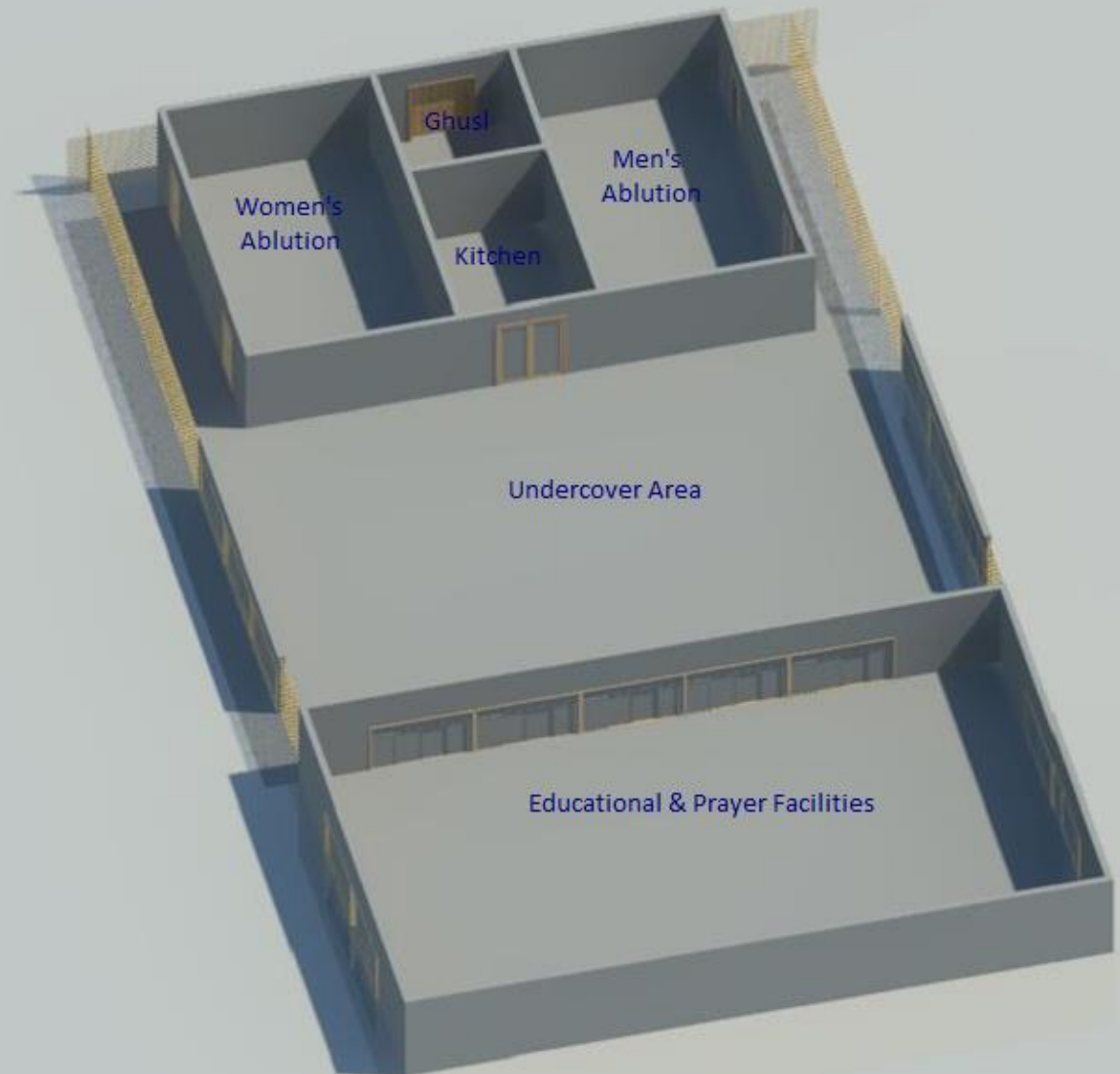


## 4 FUNCTIONAL ORGANISATION

The functions in the building are based on two principles.

The educational and prayer facilities are in the main building while amenities, kitchen and ghusl facilities are located in an adjoining building.

Both buildings are connected by a stylish undercover area that serves as a gathering point for community events.



# 5 BUILDING INCLUSIONS

Inclusions	Profile
Educational facilities	Lecture rooms for formal Islamic courses, revert programs, hifz, madressa classes and community workshops.
Prayer facilities	<p>The prayer area is designed to accommodate 400 worshippers with additional provisions available in other areas if required.</p> <p>Salaat facilities will be available five times a day, Jummah, Tarawih and Eid.</p>
Kitchen & canteen	Food preparation area to cater for daily iftar in Ramadan and other auspicious occasions.
General amenities	Includes bathroom and wudu facilities along with a separate ghusl area.
Undercover area	A modern designed area that provides a connection between buildings that will serve as a gathering point for the community on a social level.

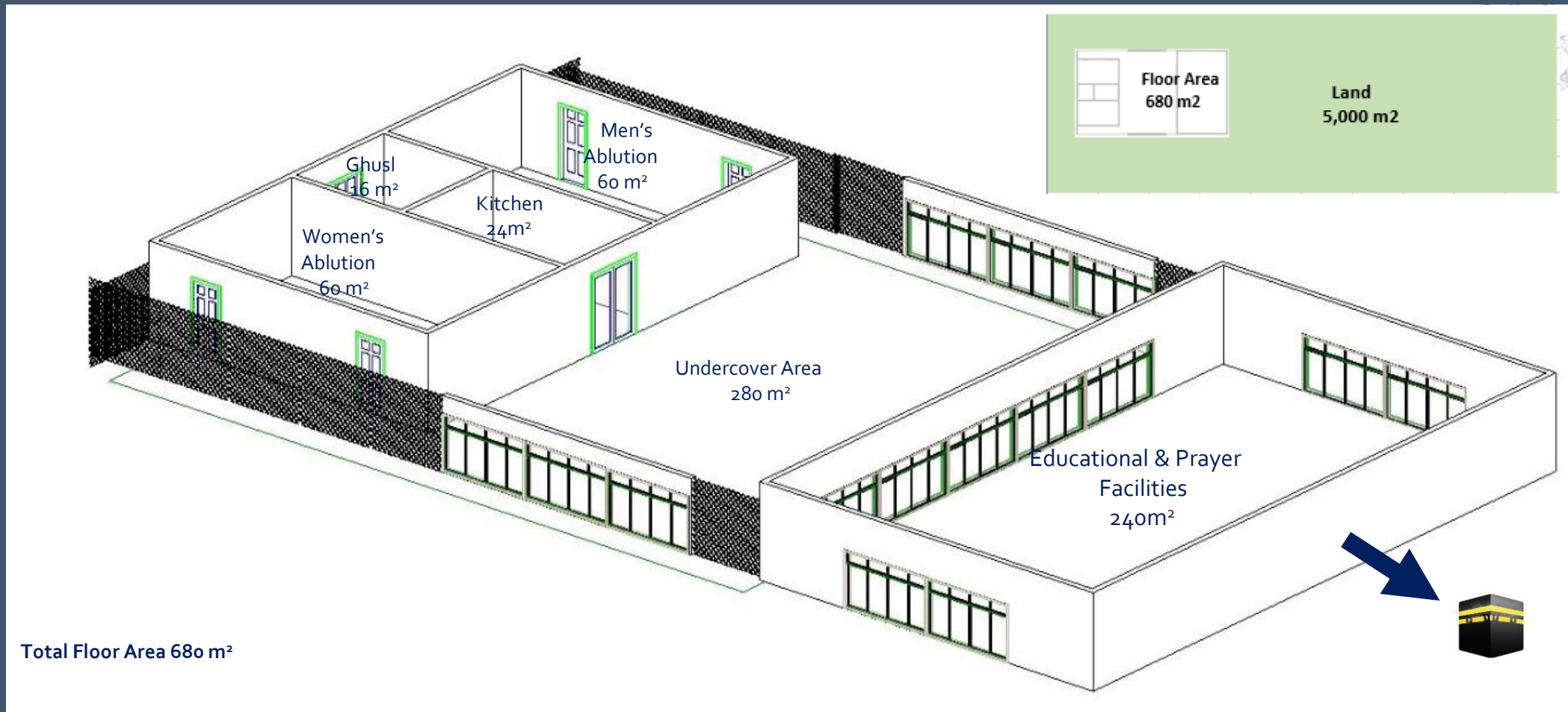
